

Volunteer Minibus Drivers

*Do you like driving?
Can you spare some time
to help Guildford young
people?*



Guildford YMCA would welcome your help.

At the YMCA we run a number of projects providing activities for young people aged 14-25 especially those who are disengaged from statutory schooling, homeless or unemployed.

Changes in legislation mean that our younger youth workers can no longer be insured to drive our minibus. People who have passed their driving test before January 1997 are automatically eligible to drive minibuses.

The trips mainly involve midweek visits to venues around Guildford, sometimes further afield in Surrey & occasionally to residential venues. Typically this involves an hour or so from about 9 am depending on where the young people are dropped off, and then a return trip from about 2.30 pm, with free time in between. Taking a group to a residential venue can involve a whole day should you be available. The trips are always be accompanied by our youth workers.

We need volunteers who:-

- Passed their driving test before January 1997 and under 70 years old
- Are comfortable working alongside young people
- Are willing to undertake a Criminal Records Bureau check to ensure the safety of our young people.
- Are willing to undertake a short in-house minibus driving familiarisation session
