During September Prince's Trust Teams are starting in Egham, Reigate and Guildford, all run by experienced youth workers from Plantation, the YMCA's centre for youth projects in Guildford.

Guildford's Team leader Art said, "These free 12 week courses are open to any 16-25 year old. We have a residential week on Dartmoor, well away from all that's familiar. That's a special time when the Team learn about each other and about themselves. Then we throw challenges at them like organising themselves to raise funds and carry out a community project. Everyone that sticks it out can really congratulate themselves on achieving something remarkable."

A member from the last Guildford Team said, "I wanted to get my life back on track and build up my confidence. I loved my time on this course and the people on it were brilliant with the support they gave. They have always put a smile on my face every single day."
